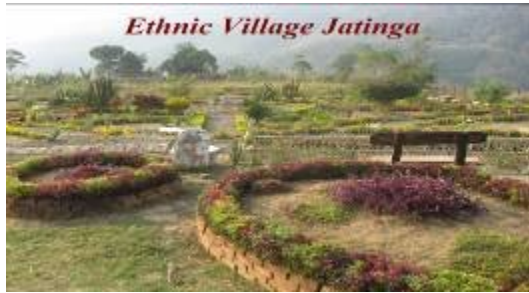

About the village-N. Leikul

N. Leikul is a beautiful village situated on a hill surrounded by a popular peak called the Borail peak. It is 16 km away from Haflong, the district headquarter. It was established in 1927 and registered in the year 1928. It is inhabited by Kuki – Thadou tribe and has a population of about 510 covering 80 household.



N. Leikul is a tourist paradise with something to interest all ages and to add it all there are –

- ❖ Water fall – 4 nos. the nearest is 0.3km and the farthest is 2.5 km from the village.
- ❖ Wild life – monkeys, wild boar, deer leopard, wildcat, fox jackals, hornbills etc.
- ❖ Garden – Coffee, tea, orchard (orange), Aloe vera, Orchid, (where we also have some rare species of the plant and for which Borail is popular)
- ❖ Honey bee rearing
- ❖ Traditional house and Modern home stay
- ❖ 3D Model
- ❖ Trekking to the Borail peak amidst rich biodiversity conservation.
